### Keynote speaker – Graham Firth

Intensive Interaction Project Leader - Leeds Partnerships NHS Foundation Trust

Graham worked as a care assistant at a large residential hospital for adults with learning disabilities in Leeds UK, before qualifying as a teacher for students with severe-profound intellectual disabilities

In 2003 he joined the Leeds NHS Trust, where he now works to support others to adopt, develop and sustain their Intensive Interaction practices or services.

As well as being the editor of the UK Intensive Interaction Newsletter and of the Leeds Partnership NHS Foundation Trust, Intensive Interaction Web page ([www.leedspft.nhs.uk](http://www.leedspft.nhs.uk)), he is a member of Leeds Partnerships NHS Trust Severe Challenging Behaviour Team.

Graham has been at the centre of the development of the Intensive Interaction Institute, which has become the central body for defining, developing and disseminating the theory and practice of Intensive Interaction across the UK as well as being the catalyst for the growing network of Regional Support Groups across the country.

**About Intensive Interaction** - Intensive Interaction is an approach to working with learners who experience Profound Intellectual Disabilities, sometimes in association with Autistic Spectrum Disorders. These learners experience a complex range of disabilities that cause social and educational isolation and are often considered to be one of the most challenging groups of people to teach and care for in our community. The approach continues to gain momentum in a range of settings and services across Australia and New Zealand as training and experience is disseminated.

**Aim of the Conference** - This conference will build on the success of the Inaugural Conference held in Brisbane 2008 and promote continued development of the momentum that has accumulated across Australia and New Zealand will present a forum to reflect on and discuss the use of Intensive Interaction in settings including schools, day services, residential units and learner's homes, as well as to celebrate innovation.
