For articles submitted the following guidelines should be followed:

ARTICLES

- Articles should be submitted in an electronic format. Articles should not exceed 2500 words including references. All major articles are reviewed by the editorial committee. The reviewers may make some changes so that the article is clear and concise. You may be contacted to make some changes to the article.

REFERENCES

- Full references should be included at the end of the article. References should be in the American Psychological Association (APA) (1994 or 2001) style.
